Union Indenture Agreement

- Is between apprentice and local JATC
- Includes length and wage rates
- Allows for probationary period
- Holds apprentice responsible for attending class

Scholarship Loan Agreement

- A pledge to work 10 years in union-contract covered employment
- If not, cost of training must be refunded
- Includes years of apprenticeship
- Rigorously enforced
